### CORONAVIRUS CLUB RESPONSE TO EASING MEASURES.

The Club, in keeping with National Guidelines, have closed all Club waters to maintain the safety of members. Government have lifted some restrictions and provided guidance for Angling.

In response, Otley Angling Club has agreed the following measures.

#### **The Club waters will re-open from Wednesday 13 May.**

- Social Distancing e.g.a gap of 2 metres between people must be complied with at all times whilst using the club pond.
- The Club will endeavour to provide some hand cleansing materials, However members will be responsible for their own sanitisers etc. for use when handling any gates, padlock or any other Club equipment.
- All pegs on the pond will be assessed for a safe distance and if any are too close, then one will be closed.
- Angling is only permissible from pegs.

As in all cases and situations, national guidelines regarding people who should be shielding and those who are experiencing the virus or maybe showing signs of infection must be followed. It is paramount to maintain safe distancing and ensure as far as possible no-one places others at risk.

Any failure in the adherence of the above will result in the pond being closed and suspension or removal of an individuals membership.
